"The effectiveness of those investments, said Marci A. Hamilton, a constitutional law professor and an advocate for children at Benjamin N. Cardozo School of Law, is evident, and can be seen in the trials in Pennsylvania. 'I think there's more of a willingness of victims to come forward and more willingness of the support system of the victims to let them come forward,' she said. 'There was a time when if a victim came out, the universal response around them was, 'You'll get over it. Thank you for telling me but let's move on,' Ms. Hamilton said. 'The more public education you have about the consequences, the more willing spouses and parents are to say, first, I believe you; and, second, you need therapy because we all know that this has lifelong dangerous effects.'"
